The previous year saw the initiation of "Team Talk," a talk show contest designed for High School and Higher Secondary School students.

Direction to the Participants

- A team of two Students exclusively from either High School or Higher Secondary School can participate
- There is no restriction on the number of teams from institutions
- The duration of the presentation should be 5 minutes
- The language of the presentation should be English
- Judgement will count the exposition of the main theme, verbal clarity, body language and use of effective language.
- A cash prize of Rs. 1500, Rs. 1000 and Rs. 500 will be awarded to the 1st prize winner, 1st runner-up, and 2nd runner-up respectively from each category
- The decision of the judges as regards the result of the competition will be final and binding
- The participants must produce their school ID cards on the day of the presentation
- Registration for the event should be done team-wise. For more than one entry from the same institution, teams are to register separately.
